


Stitching Your Monogram Boudoir Pillow

Stitches: Use your practice canvas to master the Basketweave Stitch and the Diagonal Scotch Variation.

Fiber: 6 Ply (strands) Filament Silk



Step 2: Inspect your Monogram Stitch Pattern. Note that each column of each initial is 9 stitches wide.

Step 3: Using the Basketweave Stitch and your darker color, stitch your center initial first, beginning with the left side. Then progress to the other initials, taking care to copy your stitch pattern precisely.

Step 4: Using the Basketweave Stitch and your lighter color, stitch the voids within each initial, taking care to stay inside the white pre-stitched circular perimeter.

Step 5: Using the Basketweave Stitch and your darker color, stitch the perimeter border as indicated, maintaining a width of 10 stitches all around.

Step 6: Using the enclosed seam ripper, gently remove the white perimeter stitching around your initials.

Step 7: Using the Diagonal Scotch Variation, stitch your background color around the perimeter of the monogram, staying inside the previously stitched border.
