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Ingredients For Your Monogram Bag Tag/Key Fob/Ornament

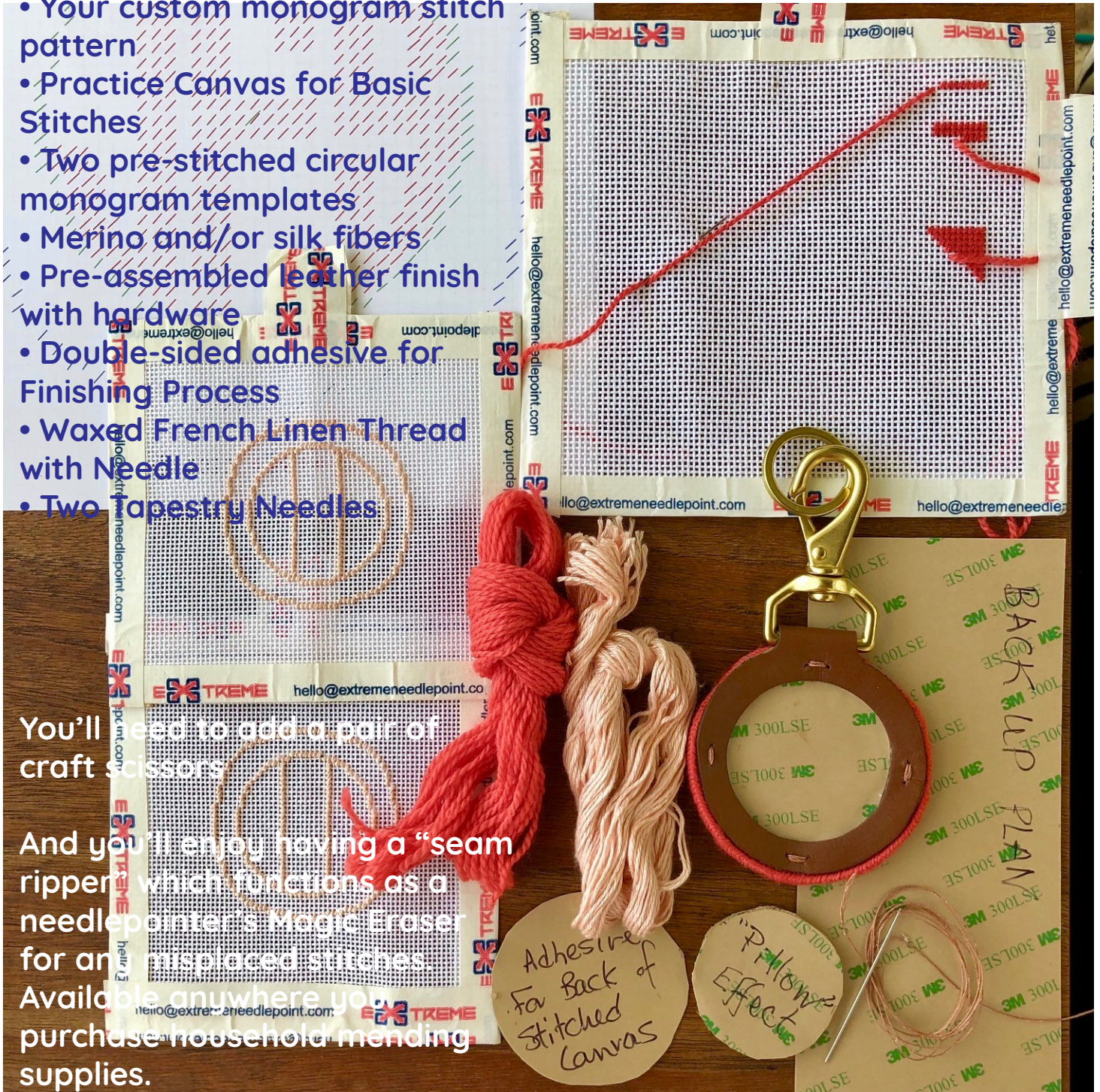
We've got this in the bag!

- Your custom monogram stitch pattern
- Practice Canvas for Basic Stitches
- Two pre-stitched circular monogram templates
- Merino and/or silk fibers
- Pre-assembled leather finish with hardware
- Double-sided adhesive for Finishing Process
- Waxed French Linen Thread with Needle
- Two Tapestry Needles

You'll need to add a pair of craft scissors

And you'll enjoy having a "seam ripper" which functions as a needlepointer's Magic Eraser for any misplaced stitches.

Stitching Your Monogram Bag Tag/Key Fob/Ornament

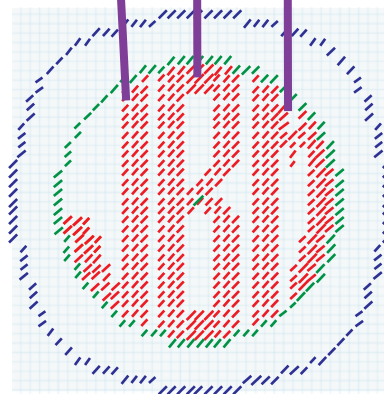
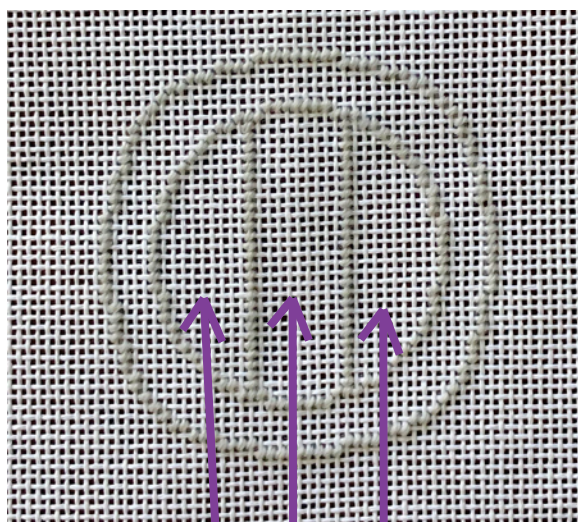
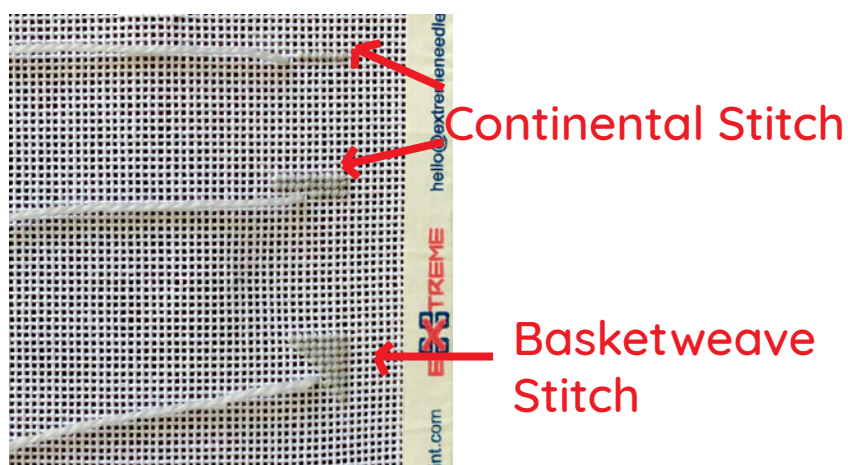
Step 1: Use your practice canvas to master the Continental Stitch and Basketweave Stitch. Concentrate on the Basketweave Stitch, as this stitch will give you superior quality in your finished canvas.

Step 2: Inspect your Monogram Template Canvas. Note the pre-stitched vertical lines. These lines enable you to properly locate your initials.

Step 3: Inspect your Monogram Stitch Pattern. Note that each column of each initial is 3 stitches wide.

Step 4: Using the Basketweave Stitch, stitch your center initial first, beginning with the left side. Then progress to the other initials, taking care to copy your stitch pattern precisely.

Step 5: Using the Basketweave Stitch, stitch your background color around each initial and around the perimeter of the monogram, staying inside the pre-stitched outer circle.



That's all there is to it!
